# DOWNING, J.

This appeal arises from the confiscation of a prisoner's book, *The Theology of Time*. Plaintiff/Appellant, Mark Anthony Delafosse, an inmate in the custody of the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, seeks a review of the district court judgment dismissing his suit with prejudice.

The Commissioner's Report dated July 6, 2005, adopted by the district court in its August 4, 2005 judgment, adequately explained that the Department's decision to deny the book was logically based on legitimate security concerns. The material in the book could cause trouble between the races, and the threatening tone of the author could encourage fear and intimidation. After a thorough review of the record, we find no error in the district court judgment. The district court judgment is affirmed by summary disposition in accordance with Uniform Rules - Courts of Appeal Rule 2-16.2A(5), (7), and (8). Costs of this appeal are assessed to plaintiff/appellant, Mark Anthony Delafosse.
