MCDONALD, J.

This is the second appeal filed by Leonard E. Dunbar in this case. In **Dunbar v. Louisiana School Employee Retirement System**, 2005 CA 2524 (La. App. 1 Cir. 11/3/06) (unpublished), Mr. Dunbar appealed the September 20, 2005 judgment that dismissed his suit. In that opinion, we addressed the merits of his case and affirmed the dismissal of his suit.

This is an appeal from a judgment dated January 4, 2006, that denied Mr. Dunbar's motion for the refund of a filing fee of \$193.00. After a thorough review, we find no error in the trial court judgment and affirm. Dunbar is cast with the appeal costs.
